# THE WINES



## 2019 BLANC DE NOIRS Benoist Ranch, Sonoma Coast

Our Blanc de Noirs opens with aromas of lemon zest, rounded out by soft vanilla and a hint of tart cherry. On the palate, a creamy mouthfeel and perfectly balanced acidity carry this classic through the persistent finish. Fresh oysters, ahi tartare or lemon meringue complement this sparkling beautifully.

COMPOSITION 77% Pinot Noir, 23% Chardonnay

METHOD on tirage for 3.5 years prior to disgorging

ALCOHOL 14.9%



# 2022 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR Petaluma Gap, Sonoma County

Our inaugural Rosé of Pinot Noir has strawberry, lime, lavender and slight petrichor aromas. Ruby red grapefruit flavors are balanced with a bright acidity and a rounded mineral finish.

COMPOSITION 100% Pinot Noir AGING stainless steel

ALCOHOL 13.0%



### 2018 PINOT NOIR Benoist Ranch, Sonoma Coast

Distinctive in every vintage, aromas of rose hips, black tea and savory dried herbs give way to flavors laced with minerality, Luxardo cherries, cola, sweet dark red fruits led by black cherry, with notes of blackberry bramble, cloves and cinnamon spice.

COMPOSITION 100% Pinot Noir
AGING French oak
ALCOHOL 14.5%



# 2019 MERLOT Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County

The Dry Creek Merlot opens with aromas of dried plum and Allspice. The palate is rich and opulent with flavors of plum Hoisin and hints of cacao that linger on the palate long after the last sip. Pair this wine with Asian short ribs, five spice grilled chicken, or molé enchiladas.

COMPOSITION 89% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon

AGING 17 months in French and American oak (28% new), Cabernet aged exclusively

in American oak

ALCOHOL 14.6%



### 2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON Mallacomes Ranch, Knights Valley, Sonoma County

Enticing purple hues in the glass give way to aromas of dark cherry, Madagascar vanilla, notes of mocha, caramel, and baking spices. This wine is dense, yet gracefully structured with balanced acidity. Abundant dark fruit and gentle brown sugar notes flow through the long finish. A worthy illustration of all that Knights Valley has to offer.

COMPOSITION 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

AGING 20 months in French oak, 7% new

ALCOHOL 14.9%
